He has the capacity to finish well if he can find a way to get out in time. **4 I Am D**. made a mistake in the stretch last time and is a bit difficult to predict after that race. Normally, he should be considered early in this field. **8 Madagascar** is making his seasonal debut. He has a difficult starting position and may need a race under his belt.
